

## **Coral Reef High School**

### **ID and Dress Code Detention Policies**

Students will receive an After School Detention any day they commit ID and Dress Code Violations:

- A. Students will have 1 week from the date they receive their detention to serve it.  
(NO EXCEPTIONS!!)
- B. After School Detentions can be served Monday through Thursday from 2:30-3:30pm.
  - 1. When serving a detention, students must turn in their ID in the Attendance Office no later than 2:30 pm.
  - 2. Students are expected to follow Dress Code when serving a detention, unless they are serving on the day they got the detention for a Dress Code violation.
  - 3. Students may not socialize in any way or complete any school work during After School Detention.
- C. Detentions ARE NOT re-arranged due to after-school employment or extra-curricular activities.
- D. If a student fails to serve their After School Detention within 1-week of receiving it, the student may receive a Referral for Defiance of School Authority and Failure to Comply w/Previous Corrective Strategies, be placed on Conduct/Attendance Probation, and/or be assigned Indoor Suspension.
- E. There are no LUNCH TIME detentions or SATURDAY SCHOOL for unserved detentions.

### **Detention Policies for Unexcused Tardies**

Students will receive an After School Detention upon receipt of their 9<sup>th</sup> unexcused tardy, and any tardy thereafter during the 2019-2020 school year:

- F. Students will have 1 week from the date they receive their detention to serve it.  
(NO EXCEPTIONS!!)
- G. After School Detentions can be served Monday through Thursday from 2:30-3:30pm.
  - 1. When serving a detention, students must turn in their ID in the Attendance Office no later than 2:30 pm.
  - 2. Students are expected to follow Dress Code when serving a detention, unless they are serving ON the DAY they GOT the detention for a Dress Code violation.
  - 3. Students may not socialize in any way or complete any school work during After School Detention.
- H. Detentions ARE NOT re-arranged due to after-school employment or extra-curricular activities.
- I. If a student fails to serve their After School Detention within 1-week of receiving it, the student may receive a Referral for Defiance of School Authority and Failure to Comply w/Previous Corrective Strategies, be placed on Conduct/Attendance Probation, and/or be assigned Indoor Suspension.
- J. Upon receipt of the 20<sup>th</sup> unexcused tardy the student will be suspended from all extra-curricular activities pending a review by the district office. Also, student may be exited from Coral Reef High School.
